The B0 floor also houses four group study tables. These stations, located next to the windows overlooking the inner garden, were designed to provide students with the opportunity to collaborate with each other during their exam preparation. Unlike the reading room seat reservations, tables here may be reserved by either calling the library or contacting the reception desks. Tables may be reserved by at least two persons, and up to a small group of people.
